

Peasy Scarf by Meg White



Pretty + easy = Peasy.

This scarf is perfect for presents. Made on your biggest needles with a pattern that repeats a single line, this is an impressive quickie. Using only 150 yds, it's affordable, too.

Why wait? Finish your holiday knitting this week.

Notes: Slip first stitch on every row purl-wise tbl with yarn in front to make a nice edge.
Fringe is a nice addition.

Materials:

2 skeins Berrocco Foliage, or 1 skein Manos del Uruguay Hand Kettle Pure Wool,
or any Bulky thick'n'thin yarn (~150 yards)

Size 17 needles

Instructions:

Cast on 17 stitches (or a multiple of 3)

Set-up row: Knit across.

S1, (YO, K2tog, K1)x5, Yo, K2tog – repeat on every row for desired length.

Knit across.

Bind off.
